Topic: Serving Together in Unity

Theme Scripture: 1 Peter 4:10

As each one has received a gift, minister to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

Serving Together in Unity - (Psalm 133:1-3; John 17:20-23; 1 Corinthians 12:12-20; Romans 12:4-5)

God calls His people to serve together, not as isolated individuals, but as one unified body in His work. Unity reflects the very heart of Christ and empowers the church to accomplish far more than any one person could alone. The Body of Christ functions at its best when every member is engaged and working in harmony. Remember, in God's eyes no gift is too small, no role insignificant, and no contribution unnoticed.

Key Ideas: God's Design Is Unity

- Unity is not just effective—it is deeply pleasing to God.
- Where there is unity, God promises and commands His blessing.
- Our unity, expressed through our gifts, becomes a powerful witness to the world. The way we love, serve, and work together should make Christ visible to others.
- Reflect on this: Jesus made unity a priority in His prayer—because it reveals God's heart and advances His purpose.

Prayer Focus

Spend time in prayer asking God for :

- A servant's heart.
- Unity in our church and that every member would find their place in the ministry.
- Protection from what damages unity the most in churches - selfishness.
