Topic: The Spiritual Gift of Administration Part 2

Definition: The Spiritual Gift of Administration is the God-given ability to organize, lead, manage, and implement plans effectively and efficiently so that the Body of Christ functions smoothly and fulfills its mission.

1. *What is the purpose of the Gift of Administration? (Ephesians 4:12)*

The gift of administration is given in order to:

- a. Ensure effective ministry operation
- b. Bring unity and structure to the church
- c. Maximize the impact of other spiritual gifts
- d. Free others to focus on their calling

2. *What are some strengths and possible pitfalls of this gift? (Phil. 2:3-4)*

Strengths:

- a. Strong leadership and organizational skills
- b. Strong and clear vision execution
- c. Smooth efficiency in the ministry

Potential Pitfalls:

- a. Over-controlling can arise
- b. Being focused more on structure than people
- c. Burnout from taking on too much

3. *How to deeper develop the Gift of Administration*

- a. Seek God's wisdom – **James 1:5**
- b. Serve faithfully in small responsibilities – **Luke 16:10**
- c. Practice delegation – **Exodus 18:20-21**
- d. Stay Spirit-led, not just task-driven – **Galatians 5:25**
- e. Maintain a servant's heart in your work – **Colossians 3:23-24**
