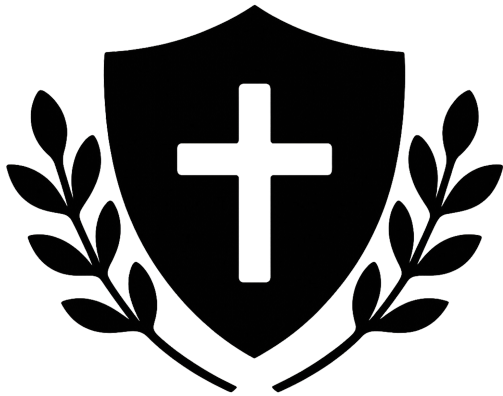


How to Protect Against and Survive a Satanic Attack

Core Scriptures: Matthew 4:1 – 11; Ephesians 6:12–17

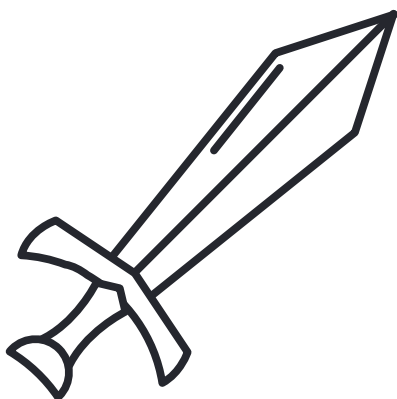


4. Carry the Shield of Faith. (*Ephesians 6:16*)

The most powerful asset we have as believers is our faith. It helps us to resist the Enemy's temptations by thinking; I know I have this need, but I trust in God. So, I will wait for the Lord to provide for it in His way and in His time. We are well protected behind the shield of faith.

5. Wear the Helmet of Salvation. (*Ephesians 6:17*)

The mind is Satan's battlefield; it needs to be conscientiously and effectively guarded. In a spiritual battle, our assurance that we are saved will help repel the Enemy's lies, which might cause us to question God or to think contrary to Scripture. Certainty helps keep our minds steady in the battle, as well as our service to the Lord.



6. Carry the Sword of the Spirit. (*Ephesians 6:17*)

God's Word is both an offensive and defensive weapon. It makes inroads for the gospel (Hebrews 4:12) and protects us against attacks. As Jesus proved in His desert temptation, the Devil cannot stand against the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God!

The spiritual battle raging around us is real and fierce. We are not in the reserves for the battle, simply waiting to be called up. We are IN the war. Soldiers of God, Are you fully dressed for the battle?
