Topic: Final Reflection - A Life of Service

Theme Scripture: 1 Peter 4:10

As each one has received a gift, minister to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

A Life of Service - (Mark 8:25 & 10:45; Galatians 5:13; Philippians 2:3; Colossians 3:23; Proverbs 11:25; Matthew 25:21 & 20:26-28; 1 Peter 4:10)

A life of service is a core expression of Christian faith. Jesus modeled servant leadership, calling His followers to love God and others through humble, sacrificial service. Jesus came not to be served, but to serve. As His followers, we are called to a life of service.

Key Ideas:

1. Jesus - Our Ultimate Example

- Jesus, though fully God, chose humility and service.
- True greatness in God's Kingdom is not measured by status, but by willingness to serve others.

2. Serving with Love and Humility

- Christian service flows from love, not obligation or recognition.
- Humility allows us to see needs around us and respond with compassion.

3. Serving According to Our God-Given Gifts

- God equips each believer with gifts meant to bless others.
- Service looks different for each person but is equally valuable and vital to the Body of Christ.

4. The Reward of a Servant's Life

- God sees and rewards faithful service.
- While earthly recognition may be absent, eternal reward is promised by God.

5. Serving as Worship to God

- Service is an act of worship done unto the Lord.
- Even unseen acts of service to others honors God.

Prayer Focus

Ask God, through prayer, for:

1. The ability to serve someone without expecting anything in return.
2. Ways that I can follow Jesus' example of humility on my daily service.
3. Revelation to see if I am serving out of love or for recognition.
