

## He Knows.....

Omniscient- **adjective**- Having infinite awareness, understanding, and insight; complete knowledge.

**God is omniscient.** That means that He knows everything. He knows the future, the past, and everything that is going on in this moment. He knows every subject in every school that ever existed (He specializes in science, technology, physics, engineering, mathematics, architecture, and the most impactful book/subject of them all - The Bible). He knows the pressures of providing for a family and running a business. He knows every-time someone has wronged you, slandered your name, or spread vicious rumors about you. He knows every weakness, every strength, every single hair on the head of everyone (died or alive). But more personally, He knows everything about You and Me!

Psalms 139:1-4, Luke 12:4-7, Jeremiah 29:1-14

**Because God is omniscient we can be real with him and ourselves.** God's omniscience means we don't have to pretend with Him. We don't have to clean up our thoughts and emotions before we approach Him. He already knows everything.

God understands why we're upset. He knows the root of our insecurities, disappointments, and our needs. He can handle our doubts, fears, and critical thoughts. He's the perfect One to guide us to peace, health, and healing. Call out to your Father for any and all things. He knows what you need, when you need it (if you are humble enough to express it to him) and absolutely excels at providing for his children. His Unconditional Love" for his people can't even be put into words.

**Because God is omniscient** He knows when someone has done you wrong, He knows when someone is out to tarnish your name, He knows when people lie to you, He knows every time you're disrespected, He knows when people try to take advantage of you. The Bible is very clear on our role with seeking revenge. In Romans 12:19, God tells us to never take revenge

and to leave it to the Lord. He tells us to forgive them for my name sake and leave the punishment to me. God is the ultimate judge and when we seek revenge, we are taking HIS PLACE. When we become overwhelmed with what others have done wrong, we become filled with anger and find ourselves focused on hate. God's love and forgiveness is seen in our ability to love and forgive.

We were all made by the concise and precise Master, the Alpha, the Omega, the beginning and the end, Jehovah El Rio- God who sees, Jehovah Elolam- Everlasting God, Jehovah Avinu- Lord, our father, Abba, the Great "I am", HE is and will always be "OUR FATHER!"

Jeremiah 32:17-19, James 4:13-17

**Because God is omniscient** He knows our heart. The heart is deceitful and desperately wicked, and because we are all so easily influenced by the world around us, our hearts need guarding. The heart is one of the most commonly used words of the Bible. When used metaphorically (depending on the context) the heart refers to your mind, your emotions, the will of a person, the sinful nature, to the person as a whole, and more inclusively the total inner man - your makeup. The term "heart" is a very important word because God is so deeply concerned about the inner man or the condition of the heart.
