Serving with Humility – (1 John 3:18; Ephesians 4:12; Mark 9:35; Romans 12:6–8; Philippians 2:3–7)

Jesus Christ, though fully divine, humbled Himself and took on the role of a servant to minister to everyone He encountered. In the same way, we are called to serve, not for recognition or praise, but out of love and humility. When we serve with a humble heart, God's grace is revealed through our lives..

Key Ideas

- Your gifts are an expression of God's grace in your life.
- Using your gift points people not to you, but to God, the giver of all gifts.
- Misusing, neglecting or hiding your gift diminishes the Body of Christ's strength.
- Serving others with humility is how we honor God with the gifts He has given us.

Prayer Focus

Spend time in prayer asking God for :

- A servant's heart.
- The ability to see others through the eyes of Christ.
- The knowledge and wisdom on how to use your gifts in humility to bring glory to God.
