


# The Certainty of God's Judgement

#### God's Judgement is unavoidable.


Key Verse: 1 Kings 22:34

Sometimes people escape reality disguising by themselves - changing jobs, moving to a new city, even changing spouses. But God sees and evaluates the motives of each person. Any attempted disguise is futile.

### God's Judgement is fair and just.
